FRP has a proud history as Waltham Forest's oldest social enterprise and a pioneer of environmental sustainability across East London. Since our launch in 1989, we've reclaimed over 800,000 litres of paint, diverting it from incineration or landfill. We've promoted green practices, participated in community events and projects, provided affordable and sustainable recycled products for the people in the community, and worked with amazing volunteers who are often among the most marginalised and isolated in our society.

We're confident that we are making a positive impact, whether it's the stories of volunteers who tell us how FRP has helped them regain their confidence, or the 2,500 tonnes of CO2 equivalent we've helped to save through our work.

Promote and Catalyse Re-Use as an Environmental and Social Solution

Continue our work to recycle and upcycle waste paint, timber and fabrics into high-quality but low-cost products for retail, ensuring these materials are managed sustainably and add value to the community.

Continue to run the new Walthamstow Tool Library, supporting local residents to re-use, repair and create.

Explore new ways to bring local social and environmental benefits reflecting the needs of the local community.

Explore opportunities for partnerships with other organisations, including those offering re-use in other waste streams and product areas, to make it easier for local people to navigate and benefit from the local re-use ecosystem.





Enhance the Reach and Awareness of our Services and Engagement within the Community

Continue our community and volunteering programmes, providing a growing number of local residents with opportunities to contribute to projects that benefit the environment whilst supporting them to play an active role in the community.

Provide our volunteers with support and skills. Provide extended volunteer pathways led by individuals' needs and interests, seeking to boost their access to the jobs market.

Offer activities to the community and volunteers that are accessible and flexible to those who wish to participate, including by expanding our offer of workshops and volunteer sessions whilst maintaining our more structured programmes and initiatives.

Increase our visibility within our local community, becoming better known among residents who may benefit from our work.

Grow our Retail Presence and Income

Grow our retail income to create better impact and financial sustainability for the charity.

Increase our online and physical presence, so more people are aware of and able to access our retail offer.

Explore the potential to move to a single, appropriate site to bring the organisation together and improve accessibility.
